Illustrated with more than 100 photos, the album features a collection of 14 removable facsimile documents that bring the reader eerily close to the world of these violent criminals. They include O.J. Simpson's intake photo from High Desert State Prison, the graded paper "Guns in Schools" written by Columbine High School shooter Eric Harris, and a childishly taunting note from Beltway Snipers John Allen Muhammad and Lee Boyd Malvo. 63.
